Welcome to Wine Country Theatre's production of the landmark American musical, *Gypsy*!

Based on the memoirs of burlesque star Gypsy Rose Lee, *Gypsy* recounts the life of the legendary stage mother, Madame Rose, and her brazen pursuit of fame for her two daughters. She dreams of their future on the stage and refuses to take "no" for an answer, despite the waning popularity of vaudeville. Often hailed as one of the greatest American musicals ever made, *Gypsy* offers a classic score by Jule Styne and an often hilarious, yet heartbreaking depiction of the price of stardom for one family. It has been described by *The New York Times* critic Frank Rich as "Broadway's own brassy, unlikely answer to *King Lear.*"

As you will quickly understand, one of the reasons *Gypsy* is so widely performed and continues to be revived every few years on Broadway is the powerhouse book and superb music. We smile, laugh, and cry at the story before us. The show is a powerful reflection of how the decisions we make can have damaging consequences for our loved ones and for ourselves.


